## LIVELIHOOD ENHANCEMENT:

BISWAS in collaboration with BSSS worked towards livelihood enhancement at the grassroots by improving the agricultural practices. In continuation to the program from the previous year the focus was drawn towards

- Training on integrated nutrient management
- Training of integrated pest management
- Training on soil testing



## INTERVENTIONS:

- Nutrient Management – Training to 115 farmers on adoption of green manure, usage of cow dung and vermi compost in the field.
- Pest Management – Training to 100 farmers on managing pest through utilization of pheromone trap, T techniques.
- Soil testing – 15 training programs on soil testing

GPs covered – Kumbhiragadi (Bhograi), Gopinarayanpur(Jaleswar), Bishnupur (Baliapal)

## LIVESTOCK VACCINATION:

During monsoon the livestock are adversely affected and suffer from different forms of disease. Hence, it becomes necessary to vaccinate them from harmful infections. BISWAS collaborated with the veterinary department, Veterinary Surgeon, Go-mitra and actively contributed towards livestock vaccination.

GPs covered – Sartha, Kasafal( Sadar), Bishnupur (Baliapal), Kumhiragadi (Bhograi)
